Description I tried to create a group called "Veritas" on cluster dhhck and got this error: #<PG::UniqueViolation: ERROR: duplicate key value violates unique constraint "index_groups_on_owner_uuid_and_name" DETAIL: Key (owner_uuid, name)=(dhhck-tpzed-hnryj9s28lk3pdk , Veritas) already exists. > I suspect it is because I have a top-level project called "Veritas". These should occupy different name spaces.
