<b>Description</b> (Instead of the secret, part of the secret, or nothing at all), servers that accept tokens should log the UUID of the token.  Easiest way: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• API server always hands out v2 tokens, never v1</li><li>• servers log the UUID portion of v2 tokens, first few chars of v1 tokens (or nothing)</li></ul>
