<b>Description</b> Continue where <a href="#">#13111</a> leaves off, bringing the /users/ tree exported by keep-web up to (at least) a level of functionality and performance similar to arv-mount.  Functionality: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Add/remove/update files/dirs in collections</li><li>• Add/remove collections by name using mkcol/delete</li><li>• Copy/move files/dirs from one collection to another (possibly /users/* to /c=*)</li></ul> See <a href="#">#13310</a> for performance work associated with this  Unlike arv-mount, webdav writes should continue to be atomic: after concurrent requests to write content A to F and write content B to F, F should contain either A or B, not a mix of the two.
