Running programs with Crunch should look more like this

```
python foo.py input.txt
```

#### and less like this

```
git commit -am -
git push
arv job create --job '{"script_name":"foo.py","script_parameters":{"input":"acbd18db4cc2f85cedef65
4fccc4a4d8+3/input.txt"},"script_version":"master"}'
```

This is easier to achieve when the following conditions are met:

• foo.py is already in a git repository, committed and pushed to git@git.\*.arvadosapi.com:waz.git

We will probably need to defer:

- · Automatically commit uncommitted changes
- Automatically push to origin
