<b>Description</b> If a user has a file \$HOME/.config/arvados/foobar.conf with Arvados environment variable settings, e.g.: <pre>\$ cat \$HOME/.config/arvados/foobar.conf ARVADOS_API_HOST=blahblah.arvadosapi.com ARVADOS_API_HOST_INSECURE=yes ARVADOS_API_TOKEN=5tsb2pc3zlatn1ortl198s2tqsehpb88wmmnzmps jmzwa6payh</pre> ... then the single ARVADOS_CONFIG environment variable should be sufficient to configure an API client: <pre>ARVADOS_CONFIG=foobar arv-get <a href="#">f00ba-4zz18-t68oksiu9m80s4y</a></pre>
