It's possible to simplify this condition by saying if (ArvadosBase.find(@object.owner_uuid).writable_by.include?(current_user.uuid) rescue nil). We

just added this last week, but it's great for simplifying permission checks like this: both User and Group return `writable_by`, and it always includes the requesting user's own UUID if they're an admin. So it's one line that covers all the same cases as this condition.

I'm happy for this branch to be merged with that change, or without if there's some reason it's not appropriate. Thanks.
